Dear SJNRCS Middle School Students and Parents,

We are called to serve God by showing love and concern for others and by serving one another. We can actually grow spiritually as we encounter others in service. At SJNRCS, we reach out to one another and those around us by serving our school community, our parishes and our neighborhoods.

In the SJNRCS Middle School there is a service requirement for all students on a monthly basis starting in September. Students in 8<sup>th</sup> grade must complete 3 hours of service, 7<sup>th</sup> graders must complete 2 hours of service and 6<sup>th</sup> graders must complete 1 hour of service per month. A form, a sample of which is on the back of this letter, will be posted on Mrs. Snipes and Mrs. Fanning's Weebly pages. The completed form must be turned in to Mrs. Snipes or Mrs. Fanning by the assigned date, usually the first school day of the following month.

A Religion grade will be given for the service. In order to receive a 100, all service must be completed, the form must be filled out properly and completely, and it must be turned in on time. The completed form may always be turned in early. Points are deducted for missing signature, etc. Unfortunately, if the student chooses not to take this seriously, the grade may become a problem. We are giving you this information now and in writing so that there will be no misunderstanding concerning this requirement. The service requirement will begin in September and the first form will be due early in October. Although we encourage summer service, the hours served before September do not count toward the requirement.

There are several guidelines for the service requirement. Service may not be for the immediate family. Students may not receive payment for service. Service during the school day does not count unless the student has given up his or her recess time. Participation in the grade level service projects (6<sup>th</sup> – collecting and bagging toiletries, 7<sup>th</sup>-baby blanket making, 8<sup>th</sup> – Clyde's Kitchen) does not count. Other service at school that takes place before or after the actual school hours will be accepted. Students may always ask the teacher if a particular service is acceptable for credit.

There are countless ways to serve in our communities and we will often give suggestions and seek volunteers for particular service projects throughout the year (i.e. sandwich making for SVDP). We suggest that students volunteer as altar servers for the Sunday liturgy, work with the school safety patrol, help teachers before or after school, volunteer with the Parish School of Religion (Sunday School), work at school or parish sponsored events (such as basketball scorekeepers, food Saturday and Sunday @ SJN Nov. 17&18), and help at soup kitchens, nursing homes or shelters in the community (SJN has Family Promise frequently). We encourage family participation in service projects and in some cases parent supervision is needed. We encourage use of Pebble Tossers, a nonprofit connecting kids and families with age appropriate volunteer opportunities throughout Metro Atlanta. They host monthly projects that you can easily register for on their website: <a href="https://www.pebbletossers.com/">https://www.pebbletossers.com/</a>. Another great opportunity and very safe for middle schoolers is with Foster Care Support Foundation – the website, <a href="https://www.fostercares.org/volunteering">https://www.fostercares.org/volunteering</a>, has a list of possible volunteer tasks.
